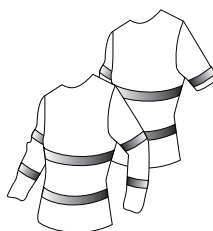


# REACH THE HIGHEST SAFETY CLASS BY COMBINING YOUR GARMENTS

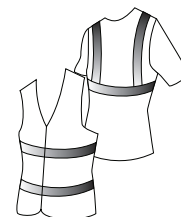
All high visibility garments are certified according to EN ISO 20471 and are divided into three different classes – 1, 2 and 3 – depending on how visible they are. Class 3 is the highest level of visibility. Garments in class 1 or 2 can be combined to obtain class 3.

We have created a quick reference guide, which will easily show how to combine your garments to obtain the requested visibility class. All garments have been given a specific code, based on type of garment and classification, for example U3 or T4. The code is shown as a symbol in the product information and in the CE label in the garment.



## UPPER BODY (U)

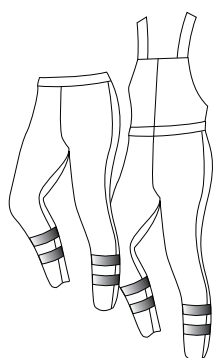
Short or long sleeved garments with reflective tape



## WAISTCOAT (W)

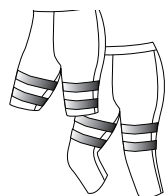
Waistcoats/Short sleeved tops without reflective tape on sleeves

**Example:** A high vis T-shirt in class 2 (labelled as U3) can be combined with a pair of craftsman trousers in class 2 (labelled as T4) to obtain class 3 certification for the whole set.



## TROUSERS\* (T)

Trousers with long legs/  
Bib'n'Brace with reflective tape



## SHORTS (S)

Shorts/Pirate trousers  
with reflective tape

\* Upper body (U) and Waistcoat (W) must be worn over the Bib'n'Brace to obtain class 2 or 3. If they are worn under, the Bib'n'brace itself determines the class.
